AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JOURDANTON, TEXAS (CITY) AMENDING CITY CODE APPENDIX A FEE SCHEDULE, ARTICLE A7.000 PARK AND COMMUNITY CENTER FEES BY AMENDING SEC. A7.001 SWIMMING POOL AND PARK PAVILLON; ADOPTING THE HOURS OF OPERATION AND ADMISSION FEES FOR THE AQUATIC CENTER AND IMPLEMENTING NEW CHARGES AS SHOWN ON THE EXHIBIT ATTACHED HERETO; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ORDER THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AMENDED FEE SCHEDULE WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CITY; DECLARING A PUBLIC PURPOSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Ordinance 361, Jourdanton Code of Ordinances Appendix A Fee Schedule, Article A.7000 Park and Community Center Fees by Amending Sec. A7.001 Swimming Pool and Park Pavilion, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council approved to amend Ordinance 365, Jourdanton Code of Ordinances Appendix A Fee Schedule, Article A.7000 Park and Community Center Fees by Amending Sec. A7.001 Swimming Pool and Park Pavilion, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to amend the City Code of Ordinances Appendix A Fee Schedule, Sec. A.7000 Park and Community Center Fees by Amending Sec. A7.001 Aquatic Center and implementing the hours of operation and Admission fees for the Aquatic Center and implementing new charges as shown on the Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the operation of hours and admission fees provided for herein is reasonable and necessary and finds it necessary to amend the Fee Schedule of the City of Jourdanton Code of Ordinances; now

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF JOURDANTON, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. That the recitals contain in the preamble hereto are hereby found to be true and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes and are adopted as a part of the judgment and findings of the Council.

Section 2. That Appendix A Fee Schedule, Article A7.000 Park and Community Center Fees, Sec. A7.001 Aquatic Center is hereby amended in its entirety as set forth in Exhibit "A".

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized and directed to implement the applicable connection, reconnection, and service charges when applicable and in conjunction with appropriate billing periods.

Section 4. It is hereby found that that such implementation is necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare.

Section 5. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance be severable, and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this ordinance and the remainder of this ordinance shall be enforced as written.


Section 6. That it is officially found, determined and declared that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this ordinance, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as may be required by governing law, and in accordance with appropriate billing period requirements.


Section 8. The repeal or amendment of any ordinance or part of ordinances effectuated by the enactment of this ordinance shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying, or altering any penalty accruing or to accrue or as affecting any rights of the City of Jourdanton under any section or provisions of any ordinances in effect at the time of passage of this ordinance.

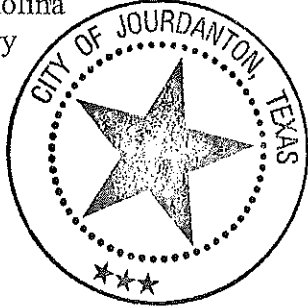



Jourdanton Aquatic Center

Municipal Swimming Pool, Splash Pad & Associated Amenities

Hours of Operation:

Monday: Closed (for maintenance)

Tuesday through Sunday: 12:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Entry Fees:

3 and under Free

All Others \$3

Season Passes:

\$75.00 per person

\$175.00 Per Family (Up to two adults and two children); add up to three family members, \$25.00 per person)

Parties:

Pool Rental Fee Chart (Pool):

The number of necessary lifeguards will depend on how many people will be attending your private rental. This number should reflect each person that enters the facility.

Jourdanton Residents: \$200.00 for two hours; \$250.00 for three hours

Non- Residents: \$225.00 for two hours; \$275.00 for three hours

Includes two lifeguards for up to 50 swimmers. If the 50 swimmers limit is exceeded, an additional cost of \$20.00 per hour per extra Lifeguard needed will be assessed.

Pool Rental Hours:

Tuesday through Thursday: 9:45 am to 11:45 am and 7:15 pm – 9:15 pm

Friday: 9:45 am to 11:45 am and 7:15 pm – 10:15pm

Saturday: 9:45 am – 11:45 am and 7:15 pm – 9:15 pm

Sunday: 9:45 am - 11:45 am and 7:15 pm – 9:15 pm

Splash Pad Rental Fees (Splash Pad):

Jourdanton Residents: \$200.00 for two hours; \$250.00 for three hours

Non- Residents: \$225.00 for two hours; \$275.00 for three hours

Includes two Splash Pad Attendants

Splash Pad Rental Hours:

Tuesday through Sunday: 9:00 am to 12:00 pm

Party Reservations:

Reservation of the party date and time slot, requires the party to be paid in full plus a \$100 deposit. Deposits will be refunded after your party provided there is no last minute cancellation, excess trash, damage, etc. to the facility. The City will retain the Rental Deposit if the cancellation is not made at least three working days prior to the scheduled event.

Event setup can begin 30 minutes prior to the event at the pavilion. Guests will be allowed to enter the facility at the start of the event. Food, decorations, tables, and chairs can be brought into the facility. No loose balloons. Balloons must be secured as there are large fans in the pavilion.

NO ALCOHOL, charcoal / gas grills, or glass containers are allowed.
